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Goring Neighbourhood Plan Consultation: until 5pm on 13th December 2017

Your comments are encouraged

The draft Goring on Thames Neighbourhood Plan and Sustainability Appraisal have been published for Regulation 14 (Parish) consultation, ending at 5pm on Wednesday 13th December 2017.

The proposed Neighbourhood Plan and Sustainability Appraisal list four sites in the parish deemed suitable for development together with supporting evidence. The draft Plan also outlines three strategic projects: traffic and parking, village centre, and the school.

A full copy of the Plan, Sustainability Appraisal and Appendices are available at the Goring Village Library in Station Road and at the Goring on Thames Parish Council office in Red Cross Road. The plan and supporting evidence are also available at www.goringplan.co.uk

The consultation is to provide people with the opportunity to consider the Plan and make comment prior to submission to the Planning Authority, South Oxfordshire District Council (SODC). This is the parish's last opportunity to amend the Plan as that cannot be done after submission to SODC. SODC will then carry out a further six week minimum consultation prior to submission to an Independent Examiner who will determine if the Plan is suitable to go for Referendum.
