Goring's Iconic thatched Boathouse partially destroyed by fire last night One of Goring's most photographed Victorian buildings near Goring lock has been badly damaged by a fire which started late last night (Friday).

The recently sold building was unoccupied at the time and no-one was hurt. Fire crews from Wallingford, Oxford City and other brigades responded quickly and the building was still being dowsed 12 hours later, as seen in these 5 photographs.
