Road Closure in Streatley - Sunday 3 March

The B4009 Streatley Hill will be closed on Sunday 3 March.

The road will be closed between the traffic lights and the road up to the School and the Coombe.





Traffic Information

for the 10K race around Goring on Sunday 3 March.

As reported in Genie's 1 February issue, the 10K race, involving about 1,000 runners, will be held on Sunday 3 March and may cause some traffic and access issues for certain residents throughout the day.


The race starts at Storton Lodge, Icknield Road at 11am and finishes at the Bourdillon Field. There are road closures in place for Grove Road and Icknield Road from 10:30am until 1pm and there will be Stop/Go signs operated by the AA on the Wallingford Road at Grove Road and at the Woodcote Road.

Advanced warning of the road closures are already in place. Residents on Icknield and Grove Road are contacted to kindly ask them to move any cars for the race. Residents who are also affected by the race on Cleeve Down and Milldown Road are also contacted.

You may like to look out for the World Record Holder, Ben Smith, who has run 401 marathons in 401 days for charity and is starting the race this year. (A good place to look may possibly be near the front somewhere!)

All proceeds from the race go to the Goring Primary School PTA who are fundraising this year for a new school minibus. For more information visit the website www.goring10K.com

BBC TV are casting in the Goring Gap!


