Goring Neighbourhood Plan

Sunday 19 May - 10 am-4 pm - Storton Lodge

After 4 years in the making by local volunteers, the Goring Neighbourhood Plan has now passed its statutory independent examination and has been approved to go to its final stage: the village referendum. If residents support the Plan at the referendum it will become part of planning policy and protect Goring. If the Plan is not supported it will not be taken into account by SODC when deciding planning applications, leaving the village at great risk of excessive or inappropriate development.

A final exhibition of the Plan's main features will be held on 18 May (Goring Village Hall Bellême Room) and 19 May (Storton Lodge). The referendum is planned for 4 July 2019.
