Goring & District Twinning Association

Annual General Meeting on 9 January 2020

The Goring & District Twinning Association has their AGM on Thursday 9 January. Given the particular importance of this AGM, it was felt appropriate to give a special mention in the Village Matters newsletter.

Just this year the Association celebrated the 40th Anniversary of the Twinning relationship with Bellême, France. Many long-standing members of the committee – some of whom have played key roles for the whole 40-year relationship – will be standing down at the end of this

year.

The nature of Twinning is continuing to evolve and the Association is keen to continue the relationship with Bellême that those members have developed, including arranging a trip to Bellême next year for the 40th Anniversary of the Bellême/Stühlingen Twinning relationship.

However, to enable this to happen, the Association is seeking to amend their constitution to reduce the size of the management committee. This will need approval at the AGM.

The Association would therefore like to extend a warm welcome to anyone with an interest in Twinning, current or historic, to attend the AGM and to support this change to the constitution. This will enable the Goring and District Twinning Association to continue with those existing committee members who are happy to stand for re-election. New committee members will, as always, be extremely welcome.
