Public Meeting on the Future of Streatley Youth Hostel

Over 50 local residents filled the Garden Room of Goring Village Hall on Thursday evening 27 February for the first public meeting with the Youth Hostels Association to hear why Streatley Youth Hostel is up for sale.

Streatley Parish Council chairman, Jeremy Spring, chaired the meeting between representatives of the trustees and the board of the YHA and those of the Stop the Sale of Streatley YHA Campaign.



The local campaign group is challenging the YHA's decision to sell Hill House, which was donated to the YHA by the Reiss family in 1936. This is despite the fact that it is profitable and one of the better performing hostels in the country, with a high occupancy rate with over 9,000 visitors in 2019, and is uniquely located at the junction of the Thames Path and Ridgeway National Trail.

Marcus Holburn, Vice Chair of the Trustees who lives in South Oxfordshire, started by explaining that the charity's aim is to protect Hill House's future and maintain it as part of the YHA. Its property director, Jake Chalmers, then explained the financial difficulties the organisation faces in maintaining the older property stock of the 150 or so hostels in the country, including Hill House, and trying to refurbish them all to modern standards which, they say, hostellers expect nowadays. He said that different models are used to manage hostels when they are not wholly owned by the YHA, such as leasing and also selling to third parties on the basis that they remain a YHA hostel, for at least three years.

Speaking for the campaign, Dr Sarah Steed, the great grand-daughter of the donor, described the original purpose of the legacy, which was intended to be in perpetuity. This sentiment was reinforced with an impassioned argument from campaigner, Rob Jones, who challenged the YHA about the risks of selling the Streatley hostel rather than keeping control by leasing it. Members of the audience also expressed concern that the property could, under the current arrangements, be acquired by a developer as a long-term investment opportunity and eventually converted to private accommodation.

Many suggestions were put to the YHA representatives for possible grant funding options and the YHA have agreed to start investigating these in order to secure the long-term future of the hostel. However, currently the property is still on the market.

'I would like to stress very heavily that until such time as it is sold to new custodians nothing will differ. The team and I will continue to focus 100%.


