


Like all communities at parish level throughout the UK, the government has instituted a national, top-down structure for coordinating the coronavirus response through the tiers of local government to parish level. The old county boundary between Oxfordshire and Berkshire, running down the river between Goring and Streatley, has created some slight differences in to exactly how parish council support is provided.


The level and type of support itself is almost identical both sides of the river, but the way it is administered and how it's accessed varies slightly due the different local government systems. As we know, Oxfordshire operates a two-tier County and District local authority system, then the various Parish Councils below. West Berkshire

There are several main categories of higher risk people recognised nationally in this crisis, eg the elderly and vulnerable people, pregnant women and those identified by the NHS as 'clinically extremely vulnerable' (shielded) people. As a result, with different levels of need, points of contact are different, even within the same parish.






