Covid-19 Update No 4. Information on the re-opening of play equipment areas in Goring and South Stoke plus a reminder of the help still available during the pandemic, with links to information from the three parish councils.



Re-opening of Play Equipment Areas – Goring and South Stoke

Goring Parish Council is working hard to try to come to a decision on how and when to reopen the play equipment. At this time the play equipment areas will have to remain closed. The government guidelines are very onerous and after consultation with our insurers there is quite a body of work to do to allow

them to be re-opened including inspections and cleaning – at this time we are not sure when it will be practicable to re-open them unless the government regulations are relaxed.

The Recreation Ground in South Stoke is facing similar challenges.
