LOCAL UPDATE – COVID-19 From The Villages Helpline @ Q1F

Goring and South Stoke remain on HIGH Alert, Tier Two restrictions which means:

- people living in Goring and South Stoke <u>must not meet</u> with anybody outside their household or support bubble <u>in any indoor setting</u>, whether at home or in other indoor venues (unless legal exemptions apply).
- people living in Goring and South Stoke can meet socially with anybody outside their household or support bubble, maintaining social distancing in a private garden or other outside space but in groups of no more than 6 (unless legal exemptions apply).
- You can continue to travel to venues that are open, or for reasons such as work or education, but you should reduce the number of journeys you make wherever possible.

Streatley has moved to VERY HIGH Alert, Tier Three restrictions which means:

- people living in Streatley <u>must not meet with anybody</u> outside their household or support bubble <u>in</u> <u>any indoor setting</u>, whether at home or in other indoor venues (unless legal exemptions apply)
- people living in Streatley <u>must not meet socially with anybody</u> outside their household or support bubble (in a private garden or at most outdoor public venues) unless legal exemptions apply. However, you **can** see family and friends, **socially distancing**, in a group of NO MORE THAN 6 outside, at a park, beach, publicly accessible countryside, forest, public garden, allotment, heritage site, outdoor sport facility or playground. 6 people includes ALL children.
- you should avoid travelling outside your area and reduce the number of journeys you make wherever possible.

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN IF I TRAVEL BETWEEN GORING / SOUTH STOKE AND STREATLEY?

- If you LIVE in Goring / South Stoke, when visiting Streatley you have to abide by the Tier Three restrictions, but Tier Two in Goring / South Stoke.
- If you LIVE in Streatley, when visiting Goring / South Stoke, you still have to abide by Tier Three restrictions.
