Streatley (and all of Berkshire) has moved into Covid Tier 4 – 'Stay at Home' – with effect from 00.01 on Sunday 20 December

Goring and South Stoke (and all of Oxfordshire) remain in Tier 2 for the moment

# LOCAL UPDATE – COVID-19 From The Villages Helpline @ Q1F

- people living in Streatley must stay at home (apart from limited legal exemptions)
- people living in Streatley can only meet one other person from another household in an outdoor public space
- You MUST work from home if you can; but may travel to work if it is not possible.
- People in Goring and Streatley and South Stoke should <u>not</u> enter or leave tier 4 areas
- People living in Streatley must **not** stay away overnight from home.
- You must **not** travel abroad except for limited exceptions such as for work purposes
- FOR CHRISTMAS: those living in tier 4 areas should **not** mix with anyone outside their own household at Christmas, though support bubbles will remain in place for those at particular risk of loneliness or isolation.

# Goring and South Stoke remain on High Alert, Tier Two restrictions. However, there are some changes:

- people living in Goring and South Stoke are being asked to stay local (and especially not travel into tier 4)
- FOR CHRISTMAS: for Goring and South Stoke the Christmas rules allowing up to three households to meet will now be limited to Christmas Day only, rather than the five days as previously set out.

FOR NEW YEAR: there will be <u>no</u> relaxation on 31 December, so people must <u>not</u> break the rules at New Year and must stick to their tier rules.
