Saturday 16 to Sunday 17 October

The Autumn 100-mile run

This will the 10th time this challenging day/night race has been based in Goring and the race HQ will be Goring Village Hall. There will be a staggered start for the 250 racers from about 9am on Saturday morning to ensure the runners are spread out and cause minimal disruption to residents and traffic.

The four separate 25-mile loops on different sections of the Ridgeway and Thames Path National Trails start and finish at the village hall, but it is essentially a continuous, non-stop race.

Runners have 28 hours to make it back to the village hall to officially finish, about half of which will be in darkness. The male course record is 14hrs 2mins and the female one is 15hrs 22mins. About 60-70% of the 250 starters are expected to complete the event.

Update on GGEO (Goring Gap Environmental Organisation)

Following the very positive response from a large number of local residents wanting to help and get involved, the new conservation and wildlife organisation is off to a good start. Plans are now underway for applying to become a registered charity (a CIO) later this year.

A meeting will be held soon for the 50 or so people who have already registered an interest, with the aim of agreeing the best way to structure the organisation with different sections and project groups etc, and also to form a Steering Group to help determine the priority issues to be addressed both in the short and long term.

Essentially, GGEO will concentrate on three broad and inter-related areas:1) Improving the biodiversity of our local flora and fauna, their habitats and ecosystems, 2) protecting and enhancing the quality of the countryside and landscape and 3) providing a comprehensive 'Knowledge Hub', an information resource about the natural world, climate resilience and sustainability. There will also be a special section dedicated to educational materials for children and young people. All of this information will be freely accessible on a new website planned to be developed shortly.
