McColl's and Post Office, in Goring High Street, is to close on 11 July

The store manager has given Genie a brief statement to say, "It is with great sadness that I inform you that the McColl's store in Goring will be closing permanently on July 11th 2022 as the company have made the decision not to renew the lease."

The chief executive of McColl's said a year or so ago that the convenience store group will look to shut as many as 330 stores over the next few years as it seeks to rationalise its store estate as part of its longer-term strategic plan.



Enquiries to Post Office Ltd have not yet revealed whether it intends to relocate its counter services to another local Goring outlet when McColl's closes in the summer. We await the outcome and also whether a new convenience store chain will take over the site.



Sad News – Councillor Matthew Brown

Goring-on-Thames Parish Council is deeply saddened to announce the death of Councillor Matthew Brown, after a brief illness.

Councillor Brown had lived in Goring for many years and an active member of the Parish Council for the last 12 years. Most recently he has been Vice-Chairman of the Council, Chairman of both the Planning Committee and the Staffing Committee and the Council's liaison on the Goring Poor's Allotment Society and the Streatley with Goring Dementia Action Forum Liaison.

During his time, when not serving on the Council, Councillor Brown was also an active member of the local Sailing Club.

Whilst being unable to attend meetings in the last few months, Councillor Brown did remain active right up to his very last days on e-mail, ensuring his voice as a

Councillor was still heard. Many of us had the pleasure of serving on various committees and working groups alongside Councillor Brown and he made a valuable contribution to life in his community and the Parish Council.

Councillor Brown will be sorely missed by his fellow members, officers and staff of the Parish Council and our sincere condolences go to his partner Jill and family. Jill has requested donations to Sue Ryder in lieu of flowers and has asked that those interested in obtaining funeral details, when they are available, should please contact the Clerk.
