**Emergency Road Closure – Streatley** 

**Until Monday 4 April inclusive** 

Wallingford Road, Streatley (A329) is closed between the traffic lights and the turning to the Wantage Road (A417) because of a major water leak which needs to be repaired

as a matter of urgency.

The road is due to re-open by midnight on Monday 4 April. Residential access will be maintained throughout and the diversion signed on site. All enquiries should be directed to: KCD on 0800 316 9800
