She then introduced Liz Shearer, BBOWT, who gave a presentation to emphasise the importance of the formation of local groups to help do what they can to reduce the rapidly declining numbers of animals and plants, which were once commonplace, but are becoming increasingly rare nowadays. This was followed by a short appeal on film by Sir David Attenborough for local groups to act now, as time is running out for many species.
