This issue reports on an emergency closure of Streatley and Goring High Streets



Emergency Closure of High Street, Streatley 8pm this evening FRIDAY

The High Street will be closed from 20:00 hours this evening (29 September), when we understand a trench will be dug right across the road outside the Swan Hotel.

The official notification states that the road will reopen on 2 October 2023 and that the closure extends from the junction with A329 Wallingford Road (at the Bull traffic lights) to the junction with B4009 Wallingford Road (at the railway bridge). This would include Goring High Street.

However, at the time of sending out this message it is not clear what the extent of the closure will be or how long it will last.

This emergency road closure is to enable SGN to repair a gas leak.

- Residential access will apparently be maintained throughout, and the diversion route will be signed on site.
- Please note blue light access will not be maintained.
