This issue is an appeal for witnesses to a fatal collision near Cray's Pond on Tuesday 2 January



Thames Valley Police is appealing for witnesses following a fatal road traffic collision near Crays Pond, Oxfordshire.

A red Smart Forfour hit a fallen tree on the B4526 near the junction with Eastfield Lane at around 5.25pm on Tuesday (2 January).

The driver, an 87-year-old woman, sadly died at the scene. Her next of kin are aware and are being supported by specially trained officers.

No arrests have been made.

Senior investigating officer Sergeant Dominic Mahon, of the Serious Collision Investigation Unit, said: "Sadly, a woman has died following this collision and our thoughts are with her loved ones.

"We would like to appeal for anyone that witnessed the collision, or saw the car prior to it, to contact us.

"We would also ask any drivers with a dash-camera who were in the area at the time to check their recordings and let us know if it has captured anything that could help our investigation.
