Streatley Crossroads (Wallingford Road/A329 Reading Road/Streatley Hill/High Street) in the Parish of Streatley will be closed from 07:00hrs on 13 April 2024, and will reopen by 22:00hrs on 14 April 2024.

This closure is to enable Volker Highways to carry out resurfacing work as part of the highway improvement programme on behalf of West Berkshire Council.

Access will be available to buses and emergency vehicles on a blue light call, under site supervision.
