You can put out a maximum of up to four additional sacks of garden waste, per brown bin subscription, next to

To be eligible for collection - the extra waste must contain only natural garden waste, such as cut grass, plants or branches and be placed in standard sized (60L) sacks or in boxes/containers totalling no more than a standard bin full. Where possible, please use cardboard boxes as these are much more environmentally friendly


