This issue reports on major road closures in Streatley due to replacement of gas mains



Streatley High Street to be closed for approximately three weeks from this Wednesday, 24 July

This is the first of five phases replacing the gas mains on various roads in Streatley

SGN Writes: Phase one - from Wednesday 24 July for approximately three weeks

We will start work on Wednesday 24 July in the High Street. To ensure the safety of everyone around our work site, we will need to temporarily close the High Street between The Swan Hotel to the junction of Reading Road.

Access will be maintained for businesses and residents and a signed diversion will be in place. Access will alter slightly as our work progresses.

The High Street will be reopened before we start the second phase of our work.

The diversion from Streatley to Goring is via A329, B471 and B4526 (via Pangbourne and Whitchurch Toll Bridge to the south) or A329, A4139 and B4009 (via Mongewell to the north).

Please note that this is in addition to the closure of Streatley Hill scheduled for 29 July 09.30 to 15.30.
