



Why? Many of these pavements had been completely resurfaced by Oxfordshire County Council Highways in August 2024 and the new work damaged the recently laid surfaces. Where work is undertaken causing damage to a recently laid pavement or road surface, there is an obligation to return the road or pavement surface to its original condition by total reinstatement. Preparation – as for the original OCC contractor work in August 2024, pavements being resurfaced should be clear of weeds and obstacles including at their edges. Whilst OCC's contractors did some preparation (and presumably Virgin Media's will too) residents wishing to ensure a lasting result may wish to ensure that their pavement is clear of weeds (which can regrow through the surface) and tidy the edges for a smarter
